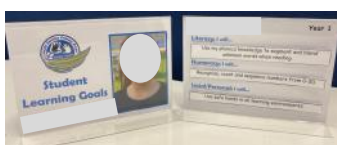
Student OnePlans: This term teachers are preparing this year's student OnePlans. At LGPS we write a Oneplan for all students. Your child's Oneplan will be shared with you towards the end of the term at the 3 way conferences. The One-Plan is a working document where each student will have aims and goals that they will be working towards, also in the document is any information that is relevant to that child such as Support Services that are supporting the student, the support that the student receives at school such as intervention programs as well as teacher, student



and parent perspectives. At the end of each term the aims and goals are reviewed, if the student has achieved the aims and/or goals new ones will be created and parents will then be notified via a letter sent home. Students will know what they are working towards, their goals will be on a display board on their desk in their classroom, any goals achieved will be on a pinup board under their name. Next time you come into school please speak to

your teacher and your child's goals they are working towards.

Preparing for year 7 in high school in 2022: This year marks the start of a new phase for our education system, as we finalise our preparations to welcome your year 6 or year 7 child to high school in 2022. We are working incredibly hard to ensure they are prepared for the move of year 7 to high school. The department is making sure that our school has all the support we need to make this transition smooth and successful for you and your child. This is a special year for students and a unique year, as Year 6 and Year 7 students will for the first and only time end their primary school journey together. We want your child to have a positive experience in their final year of primary school. Both Year 6 and 7 students will be able to purchase a 'Graduating Jacket'; your child should have brought home the letter with all the details. Please return this ASAP with payment to ensure that your child gets the Graduation Jacket. We are working with the Port Lincoln High School to organise the transition visits which will occur terms 3 & 4. The Graduation Ceremony will be held at the end of term 4 for both Year 6 and 7's.
