- Appreciate the link between land care and food availability



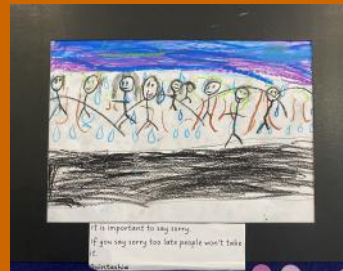
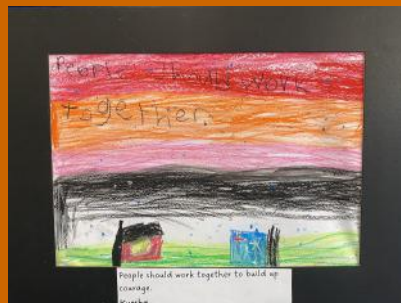
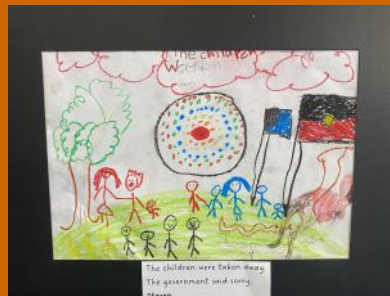
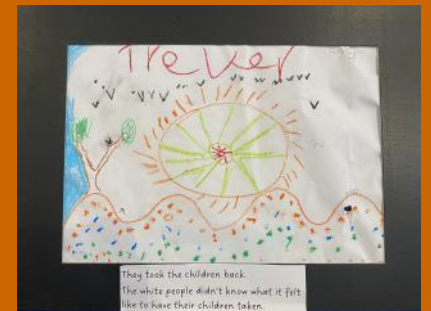
